## **NOTICE OF HEARING & INTENT TO ADOPT** MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: PLANNING CASE P13-0084 - Rehabilitation of the Riverside Main Library to add a glazed entry lobby projection, install windows behind existing screens and related minor improvements. The Library is within the Mission Inn Historic District and Seventh Street Historic District, and has been determined eligible for the California Register of Historical Resources and as a City Landmark.

PROJECT LOCATION: 3581 Mission Inn Avenue, located just south of the Mission Inn in the Downtown Specific Plan Raincross District and Ward #1.

HAZARDOUS WASTE SITES: Pursuant to Section 15087c6 of the Guidelines for California Environmental Quality Act the City acknowledges the non-existence of hazardous waste sites within the project area reviewed by this Mitigated Negative Declaration.

PUBLIC HEARINGS: The City of Riverside will hold a formal public hearing with the Cultural Heritage Board on the above noted project and the Mitigated Negative Declaration on April 17, 2013. at 3:30 pm. This item will not be heard before the time indicated, but possibly later.
