RE: PLANNING CASE P14-0096 – TITLE 20 AMENDMENT

At its meeting of February 19, 2014, the Cultural Heritage Board recommended approval of Planning Case P14-0096 and determined that the proposed case is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Sections 15308, 15060(c)(2), 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines.

There is now a 10-day appeal period from the date of the Cultural Heritage Board's decision. Appeals must be received in writing along with the required fee by 5:00 pm on March 3, 2014 in the Planning Division of the Community Development Department.
