

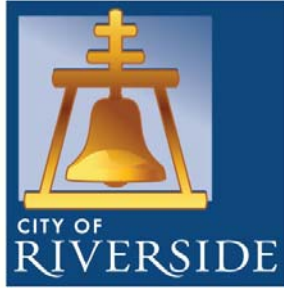

This project is intended to build on the City of Riverside’s leadership training with the focus being historic preservation. The intent is to engage the community and build a contingent of people with a focus on history and survey. Staff will hold training modules within the five neighborhood partnership areas. The City will be partnering with other organizations such as Historical Society, Old Riverside Foundation and others on both of these projects. Staff will keep the Board updated as to upcoming dates and opportunities. Following discussion, the Board took no action and accepted and filed the report from staff.</p> <p><b>WOOD STREETS LIGHTING – UPDATE</b> Ms. Delcamp stated that staff received a request for an update on the progress of the Wood Streets Neighborhood Conservation Area Lighting Replacement Project in April. Due to scheduling conflicts Riverside Public Utilities (RPU) staff have been unable to attend the last three CHB meetings to update the Board. Ms. Delcamp made a brief presentation of information provided by RPU. RPU expects the project to be completed by the end of August 2014. Following discussion, the Board took no action and accepted and filed the report from staff.</p> <p><b>BRIEF REPORT FROM THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER ON RECENT CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS AND MAJOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS</b> Ms. Gettis reported that the Mayor’s Nominating and Screening Committee did convene and appointed Councilmember Gardner to the Historic Preservation Fund Committee.
